

.CEO – Terms and Conditions

In addition to your registration agreement, the .CEO Registry-Registrar Agreement (“**RRA**”) terms and conditions set out here shall apply. In the event of any inconsistency between the terms of your registration agreement and the terms set out here, the RRA terms shall prevail.

1. Each registrant:
 - a. acknowledges and agrees that the registry reserves the right to deny, cancel, or transfer any registration or transaction, or place any domain name(s) on registry lock, hold, or similar status as it deems necessary, in its unlimited and sole discretion: (1) to comply with specifications adopted by any industry group generally recognized as authoritative with respect to the Internet (e.g., RFCs); (2) to correct mistakes made by the registry or any registrar in connection with a domain name registration; (3) if required by a URS, UDRP, CRS proceeding; or (4) for the non-payment of fees to the registry; and
 - b. agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the registry and its subcontractors, and its and their employees, directors, officers, representatives, delegates, shareholders, affiliates, agents, successors, and/or assigns from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities, costs, and expenses, including reasonable legal fees and expenses arising out of or relating to, for any reason whatsoever, the registrant’s domain name registration. This indemnification obligation shall survive the termination or expiration of the registration agreement.

2. Each registrant agrees to comply with each of the following requirements:
 - a. ICANN standards, policies, procedures, and practices for which the registry has monitoring responsibility in accordance with the registry’s registry agreement with ICANN or any other arrangement with ICANN; and
 - b. Operational standards, policies, procedures, and practices for the TLD established from time to time by the registry in a non-arbitrary manner and applicable to all registrars (“**Operational Requirements**”), including affiliates of the registry, and consistent with the registry’s registry agreement with ICANN, as applicable, upon the registry’s notification to the registrar of the establishment of those terms and conditions.
